Thank you to all of you who pray for us and support us. Your love has enabled countless boys and girls to meet Jesus in a very real way.

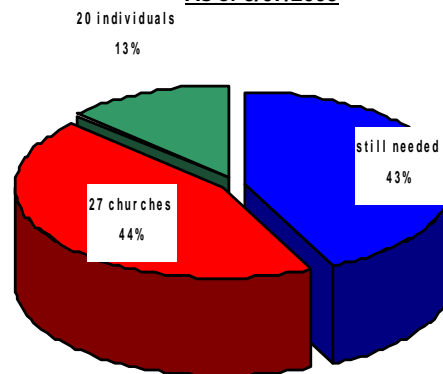
