



Awana National Capital Region Bible Quiz Paddle Protocol

1. All quizzers must have their own set of paddles, including the box, provided by their church.
2. Paddles are to remain in the box during the quiz.
3. If the box has a flap covering, it is bent backwards. The box of paddles is to be held in place with both hands.
4. When the Quizmaster says "question" all quizzers should have their eyes on the letter "B" on the handle of the "B" paddle in their box.
5. Hands must continue to hold the box until after the question is read and then the Quizmaster says "choose or select your answer" The Quizmaster will give the quizzers 5 seconds to place one hand on the handle of the paddle they are choosing for their answer. The quizzers must choose their answer at this time with no looking around (eyes should still be focused on paddles).
6. When the Quizmaster says "paddles up" the quizzers raise the paddle they have chosen immediately with no hesitation.
7. The quizzers hold their paddle in the air until the Quizmaster says "paddles down".
8. On command of "paddles down, the quizzers simply place their paddle back in their box.
9. This procedure is repeated for each of the ten questions.
10. Occasionally the quizzers will have difficulty placing their paddle back in the box. Just relax and place it the box. The Quizmaster will wait until all quizzers have their paddles back in box before going on to next question.
